## **Addendum to Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration for Blackhawk Logistics LLC’s “Blythe LNG Public Access Infrastructure Project”**

This addendum provides a schedule correction to the Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Blackhawk Logistics LLC “Blythe LNG Public Access Infrastructure Project.” The California Energy Commission has prepared an Initial Study and Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration for a proposed \$600,000 grant (ARV-11-027) to Blackhawk Logistics, LLC under the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program. The proposed grant will be used to fund the construction of a publicly accessible liquefied natural gas (LNG) facility at 450 South Willow Street in the City of Blythe, CA.

The original Notice of Intent stated that the Energy Commission would consider the proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration and grant award at the Business Meeting to be held on December 12, 2012. The Blackhawk Logistics, LLC project will now be considered at the January 9, 2013 Business Meeting at 10:00 AM in Hearing Room A, 1516 Ninth Street, Sacramento, California 95814.

Further, the public review and comment period has now been extended to January 2, 2013. All written and oral comments will become part of the public record in this matter. The Energy Commission will accept oral comments during the January 9, 2013 Business Meeting. Comments may be limited to three minutes per speaker.
