To all retail Providers/Wholesalers/Power Pools:

This letter is to alert you that on March 7, 2001, the Office of Administrative Law approved amendments to sections 1391–1394 and Appendix A of Title 20 of the California Code of Regulations, and also approved the addition of Appendices B and C to these regulations. These amendments and additions clarify existing Power Source Disclosure requirements; institutes a tradable certificates program for use by generators, pools/wholesalers and retail providers for supporting claims of specific purchases and modify the requirements for the annual retail provider report and the verification audit by a third-party.

Following are the key changes to the governing regulations:

1. Requirement for transmittal of copies of Power Content Labels to the Energy Commission as well as to Customers. [§1393 (c) (2) & (3), §1394 (a) (2) (D)]
2. Provision for use of the Internet, with customer approval, to transmit Power Content Label information. [§1393 (c) (2)& (3)]
3. Exemption from the annual audit under certain criteria for local publicly owned electric utilities that do not utilize the Independent System Operator. [§1391 (l) and §1394 (b) (2)]
4. Use of Energy Commission Certificate Program to substantiate claims. [§1394 Appendix B]
5. Implementation of Agreed-Upon Procedures. [§1394 Appendix C]
